Footnotes

QUICK TIP settled between foes early while in hand three or four wide, advanced steadily five wide approaching the stretch, took over at the furlong grounds, was roused twice with the whip on the right side and widened at the end under solid hand urging. WATCH, unhurried early and five wide until the final quarter, came out seven abreast for the drive, bested the others but wasn't a threat to the winner. SOLVIG, lightly rated near the inside from early on, lacked room briefly at the three-sixteenths pole, swung out six wide when able and improved position while not a serious threat. LITTLERIVERQUEEN, nicely placed in behind the leaders from early on, raced within easy striking distance to the stretch, angled out four wide but was empty the last eighth. SITKA, five or six wide most of the way, improved position slightly in the final stages while unable to seriously challenge. TABIANKA, in hand while tracking the leaders four wide into the stretch, battled on about even terms for the lead into the final furlong and flattened out. DOUBLY FUN gained a slim lead early, raced near the inside, battled with NOUVELLE on the far turn, was headed by that one approaching the stretch and grudgingly weakened. NOUVELLE went up early to press pacesetting DOUBLY FUN from the outside, reached the front approaching the stretch but weakened when straightened for the drive. TRUE RUBY settled three or four wide early while outrun, came out nine or 10 wide entering the stretch but failed to rally. LADY ANGHARAD (IRE) moved in four or five wide early, angled behind horses on the backstretch and never menaced.
