Footnotes

BULL MARKET vied for the lead from early on while three or four wide, dueled outside of CRAFTY CAMMACK, held a slight edge, lost it to TOIN AND BOIN in the upper stretch, then gamely came back under strong handling to prevail. TOIN AND BOIN tracked the dueling leaders four or five wide, took over in the upper stretch, then failed to hold BULL MARKET safe. GOT THE GOODS, six or seven wide most of the way, was slowly gaining at the end. CRAFTY CAMMACK contested the pace inside of BULL MARKET early, battled close up to the stretch and weakened. INTERWOVEN, outrun inside for a half, eased out a bit for the drive and offered a minor gain. TRIFECTA came out bumping BOBANDROB at the start, raced forwardly five wide into the stretch and came up empty. OMINOUS, well placed in behind the leaders early, came out five wide for the drive and flattened out when the test came. UNLEASH THE POWER was outrun. OZZIE CAT never was prominent. STORMCASTER tired midway on the turn. BOBANDROB, bumped at the start by TRIFECTA, raced forwardly for three furlongs and faded.
