Footnotes

INDIVIA opened a clear advantage three wide entering the first turn, drew off to a commanding advantage on the backstretch, made the balance of the pace and was kept to her task to hold sway. ARTISTIC ESCAPE, unhurried early and four or five wide, was slowly reducing the winner's advantage while clearly second best. ROCKINTOTHERHYTHM, near the inside to the far turn, swung out six wide entering the upper stretch and was best of the rest while no threat to the top two. BOBBIN, four wide most of the way, was empty in the drive. LIVE MUSIC, between foes four wide, weakened leaving the second turn. MY ANGEL DANCER settled between rivals three or four wide early and weakened approaching the final quarter. MAGICAL PRIZE tired on the far turn. CORRALERA raced two wide to the head of the stretch and faltered. NORMANDY'S NELL broke to the inside, was steadied soon after, angled near the rail and never menaced.
