Footnotes

TEND was allowed to settle, launched his bid circling five wide, wore down AGASTACHE inside the furlong marker and edged clear. AGASTACHE stalked the pace off of the inside, bid between horses on the turn, opened clear entering the stretch, kept on well but was no match for the winner late. SMART BID settled in hand, bid four wide between horses but lacked the needed late punch. CONCHACER was hustled along between horses three wide, but weakened in the final furlong and faded. GOLDZAR broke a step slow, was forwardly placed along the inside to the stretch and tired. WESTERN PROSPECTOR tracked the pace three wide, drew even mid turn, but faltered entering the stretch and retreated. DYNAMITE BOB was outrun. MAM BIRD opened clear to set the pace, was collared after a half and stopped once headed.
