Footnotes

SONG GIRL settled in hand three deep, tipped out and circled into the stretch six wide to make a bold bid, forged command and was all out to just last. ROYAL REWARD was allowed to settle toward the inside, advanced between horses through the turn, angled to the outside of SONG GIRL for the drive, finished well but was unable to bridge the gap. MUCHO SUENO contended three wide, drifted out further through the drive but lacked the needed late response. ADMIRED prompted the pace along the inside, but flattened in the final furlong and faded. THEKRAA set the pressured pace three wide, but faltered between horses entering the stretch and gave way. GIVHANS FERRY made a middle move five wide, offered a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. GUAVA GIRL saved ground to no avail.
