CAT THIEF, angled in on the first turn, advanced inside into the second turn, came out to challenge between rivals approaching the stretch and wore down ANSWER LIVELY. ANSWER LIVELY vied for the lead inside, was in a bit tight nearing the backstretch, continued to vie inside, drew clear on the second turn, responded willingly when challenged approaching the stretch and held on gamely to miss. YES IT'S TRUE, forwardly placed early, advanced off the inside after five furlongs, came out three wide to challenge approaching the stretch but tired in the final furlong. FIRST AMERICAN, unhurried early, made a run four wide on the second turn but could not sustain the bid. OLYMPIC JOURNEY, far back for five furlongs, made a mild gain off the inside after six furlongs but could not menace. MAC'S RULE, within striking distance off the inside, drifted out a bit once in the second turn then gave way. DR. DELOMAS, bumped at the start, was not a factor. ERLTON came in to bump DR. DELOMAS at the start, rushed up outside to alternate for the lead but stopped after six furlongs.
