Footnotes

TAKE THE CAKE, well placed inside from early on, rallied from the rail approaching the stretch, angled four wide when straightened for the drive and was hard ridden to edge clear late. BLACK VELVET LADY, in behind the dueling leaders early, eased out on the turn to rally, gained a clear advantage in the upper stretch but couldn't handle the winner late. DELASTE, outrun early, edged in around the turn, moved between horses into the upper stretch, dropped down to the rail at the sixteenth pole but couldn't offer a final response. BEE MY HONEY, squeezed back a bit after the start, was outrun for a half, made a run to reach contention approaching the final furlong but failed to sustain the needed momentum. GILDED WINGS, never far back, was put to a drive five wide midway on the turn, remained in contention into the final furlong but came up empty. CIELO GIRL, near the inside in a contending position until nearing the stretch, flattened out when straightened for the drive. DONEBROKE gained a slim lead soon after the start, angled inside, made the pace until approaching the stretch and tired. JOSTLIN KATE failed to menace. NO CHIT CHAT went up early to vie for the lead outside of DONEBROKE, continued close up for half and weakened thereafter. BELLES HONOR, six wide most of the way, faded upon going a half. SCOOTIN IN HEELS tired early.
