K. C.'S GIFT, in hand along the inside early, rallied from the rail approaching the stretch to take over, then was hard ridden in the drive to hold WITTENBERG safe. The latter, lightly rated while following the leaders four wide, moved menacingly after the winner leaving the furlong grounds but wasn't quite good enough. FAST DELIVERY, unhurried early and five or six wide throughout, reached easy striking distance approaching the final furlong but couldn't muster a late response. CROUPIER moved up early to press front-running ENQUIRY WOMAN three or four wide, continued close up into the stretch and weakened. DANCE FOR DIXIE, unhurried early, reached easy striking distance while between horses on the backstretch, angled four or five wide into the stretch and came up empty. ROSES ROSES ROSES, in a contending position while racing along the inside throughout, flattened out when straightened for the drive. ENQUIRY WOMAN gained the lead early, edged clear, made the pace for nearly six furlongs and faded.
