GLOWING COLORS, close up in behind front-running GLITTER TIME early, eased outside that one three wide on the turn, took over just after going a half, drew clear, then widened late under energetic handling. COZY COED, outrun inside for a half, moved out between rivals five wide when straightened for the drive, couldn't reach GLOWING COLORS but handled the others. SILKY SUMMER, outrun three wide for a half, moved inside entering the lane, eased out and split foes four wide in the final furlong and improved position while unable to menace the top two. GLITTER TIME sprinted clear near the inside early, made the pace for a half and weakened thereafter. MISS PENNY FORTUNE drifted out at the break, was nicely placed between horse three wide on the backstretch, continued within easy striking distance four wide into the stretch and flattened out. TEMPUS FUGIT drifted out at the start bumping ICE FOREST, raced in a striking position between foes four wide early, continued in contention off the inside until the stretch and faltered. ICE FOREST, bumped at the start, raced in contention for a half while five wide and tired. The field was late leaving the paddock in order for GLITTER TIME to have a shoe reset.
