A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, October 7, 2009 with 39 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Eight and One Half Furlongs on the main track.

GET STORMY pressed the pace off the inside, challenged once in the stretch and drew clear late. RESCUE SQUAD reserved three wide, advanced in that path on the second turn, angled out for the drive but lodged only a mild bid for the place. KINSELLA forwardly placed four wide, lacked the needed finishing bid. MAJOR MARVEL set the pace inside, responded willingly in the stretch but weakened late. MIKOSHI close up along the inside, lacked a rally. STRIKE AGAIN three wide on the first turn when within striking distance, tired in the final quarter. EL CRESPO could not menace. CEDROS lost his footing a bit at the start and was outrun.
