Footnotes

ARCHENLAND tracked the pace four wide, took over entering the stretch, edged clear and maintained a diminishing advantage. MR. PRANKSTER settled saving ground, angled out five wide leaving the turn, finished well but was unable to reach the winner. LORD OF THE ROSES disputed the pace along the inside, was collared entering the stretch, gave way but had enough left to safely hold the show. EVERYDAY DAVE was rank to place between horses early, leveled into stride three deep after the opening quarter, moved up four wide through the turn, steadied and altered course out six wide when MR. PRANKSTER came out near the quarter pole, and went evenly thereafter. MARCHING ORDERS contended off of the inside, shifted out three wide entering the stretch but lacked a response when put to pressure. ROYAL TAK saved ground to little avail. HOTNITESINMICHIGAN rushed to the lead between horses, but was used up after a half and dropped out. The jockey of EVERYDAY DAVE lodged an objection against MR. PRANKSTER for alleged interference near the quarter pole, but following the Stewards review there was no change to the order of finish.
