MARTY THE MONSTER settled in hand, launched a bold bid four wide, shook clear with a furlong to run and maintained a diminishing advantage. FORFEIT settled saving ground, angled out entering the stretch and was making up ground. GO GO SUGAR set the pressured pace between horses, weakened during the drive but stayed on to preserve the show. DUBAELE was allowed to settle, finished with a mild rally between rivals but failed to seriously threaten. LITTLE ROBBIE D broke slow, moved up six wide, offered a mild bid leaving the turn but failed to sustain the drive. GUMPER settled saving ground, swung wide and finished with a belated gain. BLACKOUT contended between horses to the stretch and faded. DANZIG GOLD failed to respond. FORTUNE OF WAR hopped at the start, rushed up along the inside, but came up empty after a half and dropped out. PEEKABOO VISION vied three wide to the stretch, but faltered between rivals and faded fast.
