Footnotes

COURTYARD, rated in behind the leaders early, moved out four wide on the second turn, advanced steadily to reach the front nearing the final furlong, leaned in brushing LADY WOODWIN for a stride, then battled on about even terms the remainder, outgaming LADY WOODWIN on the wire. The latter, well placed from the start while following front-running DEBT FREE under light rating three or four wide, gained a slim lead just prior to going six furlongs, was headed by the winner nearing the eighth pole, was brushed by COURTYARD, then held on stubbornly the remainder. HILARY LINDH, within striking distance and saving ground throughout, failed to rally. HOT TEA, well placed inside into the backstretch, moved out four wide before going a half, remained prominent until nearing the stretch and weakened. PAM settled behind foes, raced within easy striking distance, angled out for the drive but was empty. DEBT FREE sprinted clear soon after the start, moved inside, made the pace for almost six furlongs and tired. GRECIAN ROSE wasn't a serious factor. ALARMING ONE, sluggish to start, was wide while outrun and eventually distanced.
