OUR REVIVAL settled three wide early, was outsprinted, came out six wide concluding the turn, reached the front at the furlong grounds and was hard ridden the remainder. LE COSAIRE, bumped at the start by PICKI, raced six wide on the backstretch, angled near the inside on the turn, then continued inside through the drive to finish well. SARATOGA HUMOR gained a slim lead early while near the inside early, drifted out a bit approaching the end of the backstretch putting NINAMITE in tight quarters, battled with PICKI, was headed by that one approaching the stretch, regained the edge, was bumped by PICKI in the upper stretch and weakened. WHIMSICAL THOUGHTS raced in behind foes four or five, made a menacing run inside the winner nearing the final furlong, gained almost even terms for the lead but flattened out late. PICKI, difficult to load into the gate, drifted in at the start bumping LE COSAIRE, moved up soon after to force the pace four abreast, battled with SARATOGA HUMOR, put a head in front briefly concluding the turn, faltered when straightened for the drive and leaned in bumping SARATOGA HUMOR at the three-sixteenths pole. PEAK TIME, close up inside early, raced in behind the dueling leaders to the stretch, angled four wide, then flattened out when working her way out six or seven wide at the furlong grounds. WILD ABOUT MARI never was prominent. HIGH HEEL BOOTS, five or six wide in a contending position for a half, weakened thereafter. NINAMITE attended the pace early while between rivals, was steadied, sharply at the nine-sixteenths pole when SARATOGA HUMOR came out, quickly fell back, then was eased in the upper stretch when hopelessly beaten.
