SHEER LUCK settled near the inside early, edged closer entering the far turn, moved out to rally from between foes four wide approaching the stretch, was bumped for a stride at the quarter-mile ground by ROSE HUNTER when that one came out, leaned in and bumped twice more with that one soon after and prevailed under pressure. ROSE HUNTER, a bit rank for a half despite being under a rating hold while tracking front-running LOVIN THE SUNSHINE four wide, gained a narrow lead just after going six furlongs, came out and bumped the winner entering the stretch, was bumped twice by that one soon after, then wasn't good enough. LA LUNA DE ORO, never far back, advanced along the rail on the far turn, angled three or four wide for the drive but couldn't muster the needed response. BRANT POINT, unhurried early, made a mild five wide into the final furlong but couldn't offer a final response. LAVILLE, within striking distance five wide, edged in behind horses entering the stretch, came out between foes four wide in the final sixteenth and slightly improved position. LOVIN THE SUNSHINE gained the lead early, moved near the inside, made the pace for six furlongs, was headed soon after, continued close up to the lane and faltered. PRISON OF LOVE stalked the pace five wide to the stretch and was empty in the drive. LADY'S DON'T TELL, outrun from the start, wasn't persevered with in the stretch and was distanced.
