Footnotes

CRIMSON HERO, reserved three wide early, moved between foes on the far turn while edging closer, continued five or six wide approaching the stretch, briefly lacked room, split foes in the final sixteenth three or four wide and prevailed under pressure. CAPTAIN WHEAT, well placed inside from early on, made a bold run near the inside entering the upper stretch, gained about even terms for the lead, then was outfinished. BIG COUNTRY, within striking distance and five or six wide much of the way, was outside the winner on almost even terms in deep stretch and wasn't good enough. PERFECT RIDE, in contention always, made a strong bid five wide at the furlong grounds, gained about even terms for the lead but failed to sustain the needed momentum. IDEALISM stumbled at the start, was outrun to the far turn four wide, made a run six wide into the stretch and offered a mild gain. CHANGE COURSE chased front-running PLINO from early on, raced close up into the stretch and faltered. RUSH AROUND, in contention four wide until approaching the stretch, gradually weakened. ROCK BUSTER stalked the pace three or four wide, poked a head in front entering the stretch and weakened soon after. MOHIGAN HILL was outrun. OUR SHARKY failed to menace. PLINO rushed to the front early, angled inside, drew well clear, made the pace for six furlongs, then gave way readily soon after.
