Footnotes

STRUTTIN' came out lightly bumping PLAID at the start, was rated inside early, moved three or four wide nearing the stretch, took over just after the stretch call, then drove clear under hand urging. MISS HELEN WHEELS gained the lead near the inside early, made the pace until the final furlong and couldn't match strides with the winner late. PLAID, bumped by the winner at the start, was never far back, raced near the inside, eased out four or five wide leaving the second turn but failed to gain in the final furlong. FAITHFUL FLYER, well placed three or four wide to the stretch, flattened out in the drive. PEACE PLEDGE went up early to press front-running MISS HELEN WHEELS three or four wide, raced forwardly until approaching the stretch and weakened. OKAYA bobbed at the start when the ground appeared to break from beneath her, raced five wide and tired.
