MARY DELANEY gained the lead early while full of run, raced in hand three wide, was clear into the upper stretch and prevailed under mild urging while drifting out slightly in the final furlong. SANGUINITY chased the winner four wide much of the way and couldn't challenge in the late going while fully extended to save the place. CROSS CHANNEL, a bit reluctant to load into the gate, stumbled at the start to trail, was outrun to the stretch, came out seven or eight wide for the drive and finished willingly. BANDSTAND raced within striking distance to the stretch four or five wide and flattened out in the late going. FIELDABEAT, well placed near the inside into the stretch, was empty in the drive. DUTCH GIRL, outsprinted early and five wide to the stretch, edged closer to the inside but lacked a closing threat. BURLETTA, five or six wide throughout, had no rally. CELESTIAL WOODS stalked the pace four wide to the stretch and weakened. FROZEN TREAT, outrun near the inside for a half, swung out ten wide for the drive and never menaced. PUGNACIOUS MILLIE tired on the turn.
