ANY GIVEN SATURDAY, in hand from early on while following the pace five wide, commenced a sweeping rally approaching the stretch, wrested command, moved clear and was kept to his task. SAM P., bumped at the start by HEY BILL and steadied, raced between foes four wide under light restraint, came a bit wider entering the stretch and was clear for the place. SHIPMATE went up to gain a slim lead early while dueling outside CAPTAIN RAY, held on well until the end of the second turn and couldn't keep pace. BETA CAPO, never far back and four wide, made a bid from between foes approaching the stretch but was empty when straightened for the drive. DAN MCGREW, rated along near the inside early, maneuvered out six wide leaving the second turn and failed to offer a late response. HEY BILL came out at the start bumping SAM P., went up to track the pace four wide, raced forwardly until the stretch and tired. NI KEL WILLY was outrun to the lane and passed tired foes. KON KRETE KID raced forwardly near the inside for six furlongs and weakened gradually. CAPTAIN RAY contested the pace inside of SHIPMATE for three-quarters and tired.
