STAKES Buffalo Trace Franklin County S. Listed - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start, with \$100,000 added, of which 62% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: Three year olds, 122 lbs.; Older 124 lbs.; Non-winners of a graded stakes on the turf in 2006 allowed 2 lbs.; \$45,000 twice on the turf since April 7, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 in 2006, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Buffalo Trace Franklin will be limited to twelve if on the Haggin Course or ten with two also eligibles if on the Keeneland Course. In the event that the race overfills the starters will be determined with preference by condition eligibility, beginning with graded stakes winners. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A set of four silver julep cups will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, October 11, 2006 with 36 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Six Furlongs on the main track.

Footnotes

SOCIETY HOSTESS, bumped at the start by BRIGHT GOLD, settled in hand three wide, trailed for a half, split horses five wide in the upper stretch, responded to left-handed urging and drove clear late. BRIGHT GOLD came out bumping the winner at the start, raced forwardly inside, was steadied about the seven-sixteenths pole, eased out leaving the turn three or four wide to go after front-running GILDED GOLD, stuck her head in front about the sixteenth pole but wasn't a match for the winner late. GILDED GOLD gained the edge four wide early, showed the way into the final furlong and weakened. MOCHA QUEEN, five wide much of the trip and within easy striking distance, lacked a closing response. ELLA BELLE, outrun inside to the stretch, eased out three wide to make a minor move into the final furlong and failed to continue. JEWELS N GEMS, outrun for a half, came out nine wide for the drive but lacked a rally. OUR LOVE broke in front, edged in, forced the pace around the turn four or five wide and weakened upon going a half. FLYING CIRCLE, five or six wide much of the way, tired leaving the turn. MORE THAN PRETTY, used early to force the pace four or five wide, tired approaching the final quarter.
