## **Footnotes**

TRYING BRIAN, up close between foes early, eased back in behind the leaders, moved four or five wide into the lane and closed determinedly under pressure to wear down BANBURY CROSS in the late going. BANBURY CROSS unseated the rider while warming up and briefly was loose. During the running, BANBURY CROSS gained the lead three wide, went along under careful handling, shook off TIS A MAN in the upper stretch, opened a clear advantage but couldn't contain the winner's surge. HIGHEST DEGREE, outrun four wide for a half, circled rivals ten wide at the quarter-mile ground, edged in soon after and managed a mild late gain. EL POCO DIABLO, never far back and near the inside, lacked a final response. AXIOM, well placed near the inside to the stretch, angled four wide for the drive and lacked a closing punch. ALABAMA GOLD tracked the pace four or five wide, ranged up outside the winner but flattened out when the test came. TRUST YOUR LUCK, five or six wide, failed to rally. ALL ON THE LION hopped while breaking slowly and failed to menace. NICKYPALMER, outrun four wide for a half, circled foes ten wide into the lane and never threatened. TIS A MAN forced the early pace five wide, made a solid bid nearing the stretch but faltered when straightened for the drive. MANDU GENIUS was outrun.
