STAKES Pin Oak Valley View S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$7,500 by time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$750 to enter and an additional \$750 to start, with \$150,000 guaranteed, of which \$93,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth and \$4,500 to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded or Group stakes on the turf in 2007 allowed 2 lbs.; \$45,000 twice on the turf in 2007, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for The Pin Oak Valley View will be limited to twelve. In the event that the race overfills the starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded or group stakes winners, then highest 2007 turf earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, October 10, 2007 with 38 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Eight and One Half Furlongs on the main track.

Footnotes

BEL AIR BEAUTY, never far back, followed the leaders under light rating five wide, continued from that position on the course to commence her rally, took over leaving the furlong grounds and was under mild urging while well clear. BACHATA, slow to begin and outrun for six furlongs while three wide, split foes four wide in mid-stretch and was going well at the end to earn the place. PITAMAKAN gained the lead early, maneuvered in nicely to show the way two or three wide, made the pace into the final furlong and weakened. TESTAMA (FR), unhurried early and in behind foes, continued between horses when advancing around the far turn and into the stretch, worked her way to the rail in the late going but couldn't offer the needed response. STORMY WEST, outrun for six furlongs, circled horses ten wide into the lane and managed a mild gain. CALLWOOD DANCER (IRE), five or six wide, lacked a closing

account. LISA M, outrun to the stretch, improved position while not a serious threat. LONG APPROACH raced in contention near the inside to the stretch and came up empty. AUDACIOUS CHLOE pressed front-running PITAMAKAN early three or four wide, moved menacingly nearing the final furlong but flattened out soon after. SUPER FREAKY, well placed near the inside to the stretch, angled four wide for the drive and was empty. BEAUTIFUL VENUE stalked the pace four wide to the stretch, tired, and steadied in the late going. LEMONLIME tired after six furlongs.
