SPANISH BARON contended in hand between horses, came four wide, drew even a furlong out and edged away late. BAHIM settled in hand between foes, split rivals a furlong out but was unable to reach the winner. BIG FLIRT set the pressured pace three wide, opened clear and angled in, fought on through a prolonged drive but grudgingly gave in. BUBBER was close up along the inside, angled out six wide, made a steady advance and improved position. DONT POKE THE BEAR was allowed to settle, circled seven wide and was making up ground. CONSULATE chased the pace four wide to the final furlong and faltered between rivals. EXCLUSIVE ALLIANCE settled off of the inside, finished with a mild gain between horses. LIQUID FIRE was unhurried into stride along the inside, angled out five wide and finished with a belated gain. BOOT TAILS broke slowly and was never a factor. GRESHAM prompted the pace along the inside to the stretch and faded. CHANCE AND A HALF saved ground to no avail. JEMARU contended between horses three wide for a half and dropped out.
