EXPLORING bumped at the start, was in tight soon after, recovered to be close up between rivals, moved in a bit in midstretch and finished well to be in time. BELIEF SYSTEM behind the leaders, raced four wide on the turn, caught the leaders with a sixteenth to go and held on gamely. BOSTON PROPER set the pace off the inside, led the field to the final sixteenth and faltered. BAFFOONERY bumped at the start, recovered to be forwardly placed along the inside, angled out with a sixteenth to go and rallied willingly late. FIDDLER BLUE outsprinted early, raced in the five path on the turn and was no threat. TAP AND TRADE drifted in at the start and bumped the winner, raced closest to the pace three wide and tired.
