TACTICAL CAT settled inside early, was put to a drive inside concluding the turn, worked his way out four wide leaving the furlong grounds and, under lefthanded encouragement, edged clear late. TIGARD went up early to press pacesetting SAND RIDGE from the outside, gained a slight advantage in the upper stretch but couldn't handle TACTICAL CAT late. SAND RIDGE sprinted clear early, edged inside, made the pace into the stretch and weakened thereafter. HANGIN IN THERE, well placed from the start, stalked the leaders four wide into the final furlong but failed to respond. PROPER PERFORMER, outrun early and five wide on the backstretch, circled foes seven or eight wide into the stretch but lacked a serious response. POLLINATE drifted in at the start and was checked, then failed to menace. MR. KODY raced forwardly to the stretch while between foes much of the way and weakened. TROY'S PLAY was through after a half. ROBAHUSH was outrun.
