FRENCH RIVIERA broke sharply and crossed nicely inside soon after the start, quickly opened a sizeable advantage while three wide, made the balance of the pace and was kept to her task in the drive. DON'T COUNTESS OUT, within striking distance while between foes early, followed FRENCH RIVIERA three or four wide, edged a bit closer approaching the final furlong but couldn't seriously challenge while fully extended. AWAY, outsprinted inside to the stretch, came out four wide between foes when rallying, angled inside the top two at the furlong grounds but couldn't seriously menace the winner. FREEFOURRACING, outrun to the stretch and four or five wide, moved out eight abreast for the drive and improved position. MISS PHOTOGENIC, outsprinted early and four wide around the turn, came out six wide to make a mild bid into the final furlong and failed to continue. FUSE IT, outrun into the stretch, passed tired rivals. SWEET NANETTE chased the pace for a half while four or five wide wide and weakened thereafter. JUKE faded leaving the turn. CAT CAY, nine or 10 wide on the backstretch, moved near the inside around the turn and never menaced. LA GALERIE (ARG) tired approaching the stretch.
