Footnotes

FRENCH PARK gained the lead early, moved inside, shook off CELSIANA on the turn, then drew off in the stretch under energetic hand urging as much the best. LILIES FOR ROZIE, never far back and four or five wide, was just off the winner entering the upper stretch but couldn't threaten as second best. CUTUP leaned in at the start bumping CELSIANA, was outrun early, made mild move into the upper stretch but couldn't threaten while improving position. CELSIANA, bumped from both sides at the start, gained a forward position, challenged the winner briefly on the turn approaching the lane but couldn't keep pace. BLUE BAY, outrun early, advanced five or six wide into the stretch but couldn't offer a late response. PURE HOPE, outrun for a half, passed tired rivals. FASHION AIR raced in contention for a half and couldn't offer a closing account. SKIP THE STORM came out at the start bumping CELSIANA and wasn't a factor. HANNA'S HARMONY tired leaving the turn. ANGEL OF LOVE was done early. EQUITY EVENT was outrun. SYMPHONIC forced the pace early from between foes and faded.
