Footnotes

FORMAL RUSH broke in the air, was steadied to trail, moved inside, was unhurried, raced between foes on the far turn, came out six wide for the drive and was all out to be along in time. ITUNA sprinted clear inside early, was headed on the far turn by CARSON'S CLOVER from the outside, regained the advantage, reopened a clear advantage but failed to hold the winner safe. KINDLING, unhurried and three or four wide, moved with the winner while inside that one approaching the stretch, loomed prominently but couldn't get up. CARSON'S CLOVER chased front-running ITUNA from early on, headed that one briefly upon going six furlong but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. GRAND ILLUSION, outrun three wide to the far turn, swung out six wide into the stretch and managed a mild gain. REITO PEITO, four or five wide throughout, had no rally. CATS COPY raced near the inside and never threatened. PREDATORY LENDER raced three or four wide and weakened nearing the stretch.
