MAGGER BAGS, never far back and four wide, swept to the fore nearing the final furlong, was kept to her task and widened. NADESHIKO, within easy striking distance and racing inside, moved with the winner while inside that one nearing the lane, angled out four or five wide and was second best. ARTISTIC TALENT, slow to start and outrun to the lane, rallied between foes three or four wide and was going well at the end. YIPPETY YIP, within striking distance two wide for a half, fanned five wide for the stretch run and was empty in the late going. LADY HILLINGDON, within striking distance and four or five wide, lacked a closing account. SHEZA BOTHA OURS, outrun near the inside to the stretch, managed a minor late gain. ELUSIVE SPARKLE, outrun on the backstretch and seven wide, moved near the rail around the turn, continued two or three wide into the lane and improved position while not a serious threat. FAUZETA dueled for the lead from early on while three or four wide, battled with BALLETT D'AMOUR to the stretch and tired. KEPT LADY never was prominent. INTERIOR DESIGN raced three wide and weakened nearing the stretch. BALLETT D'AMOUR gained a narrow advantage near the inside early, dueled with FAUZETA to the stretch and faltered. PRANK gave way readily and wasn't persevered with at the end when hopelessly beaten.
