### Footnotes

CHESTERMITE stalked front-running PETION STATION three or four wide from the start, reached the front a quarter-mile out, shook off KELVINGTON leaving the furlong grounds and was hard ridden to hold DAN MCGREW safe. DAN MCGREW, reserved early and three wide, came out eight wide for the drive and was going well at the end. KELVINGTON, well placed four or five wide throughout, loomed boldly on about even terms for the final furlong and wasn't good enough. After being pulled on on the backstretch, KELVINGTON was vanned off. MALAMEEZE, forwardly positioned along the inside from the outset, angled four wide into the stretch and was empty late. GRAND ALIBI, within easy striking distance while between foes three or four wide, flattened out at the end. PETION STATION sprinted clear two wide, made the pace until the final quarter and weakened. KETTLE HILL raced in contention five wide to the stretch, came out wider and never fired. TOM ARCHDEACON raced near the inside most of the way and lacked a serious rally. ANTRIM COUNTY raced five wide much of the way and never was a factor.
