Footnotes

TIGHT STORM, never far back and between horses four wide, reached the front in deep stretch and outgamed WINDYINDY in the final yards. WINDYINDY, reserved early and three wide, fanned seven wide into the lane, had aim at the end and missed. DROP A LINE dueled for the lead three or four wide while outside of STARLICIOUS, took over from that one, opened a clear advantage in the upper stretch but couldn't last. SWEET DIECISEIS, outprinted early and three or four wide much of the way, improved position at the end but wasn't a serious threat. STARLICIOUS gained a slim lead early while dueling two wide with DROP A LINE, held on well until the head of the stretch and tired. BEN'S GRAND BABE, well placed in behind the dueling leaders into the upper stretch, weakened thereafter. SOUNDS OF SILENCE, five or six wide throughout, had no rally. BLESS YOU worked her way inside on the turn, raced in contention to the stretch and weakened. AU JUICY MOMMY was outrun and ten wide in the stretch. YELLOW FLAG tired on the turn. VOWEL gave way readily upon going a half.
