Footnotes

SONG GIRL stalked the pace in hand three deep, drew even nearing the quarter pole, shook clear entering the stretch and held a diminishing advantage. SEXY SUZY attended the pace between horses, angled out leaving the turn, finished well but was unable to reach the winner. BEKAT BEKAT hopped at the start to get away behind her field, commenced her rally between rivals, angled to the inside entering the stretch, finished well and was just up to earn the show. RED ONION LADY was unhurried along the inside, shifted out and moved up between horses to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. SINISTER TALE disputed the pace two wide, was collared between horses on the turn, weakened entering the stretch and gave way. RUE SAINT HONORE made a long drive circling six wide but failed to seriously threaten. SNICKER STAR was allowed to settle three wide and failed to respond. LAKE MICHIGAN vied for the lead along the inside for a half and retreated. SUPSA was forwardly placed along the inside through the turn and dropped out. TERLINGUA'S CAUSE contended three wide between horses, but drifted out leaving the turn and faded.
