VEE ONE ROTATE was allowed to settle, split horses to commence his bid inside the three-eighths pole, waited in traffic leaving the second turn, worked his way to the outside with a furlong to run, forged command and was fully extended to hold his stable mate at bay. SATURDAY LAUNCH broke slow, was unhurried into stride, came three wide to make a late rally, angled in entering the stretch, got through and finished with a rush but missed by the narrowest margin. PACIFIC NIGHTS stalked the pace three wide, forged command with a furlong to run, but weakened between rivals late and settled for the show. FREDDIE ONE BITE was away alertly, set the pace off of the inside, disputed the issue to the final furlong but faltered between horses and faded. GOSPEL HOUR was rank to place between horses, checked repeatedly through the first turn and on the backstretch, angled out four wide to be clear but came up empty entering the stretch and retreated. FRANCOIS was allowed to settle, moved up four wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. FAIRY CAT was forwardly placed along the inside through the second turn and dropped out.
