HAMMERS TERROR rushed inside to vie for the lead, took over on the turn, drew off into the stretch and held sway late. ATIGUN reserved off the inside, angled out for the drive and closed well late to be steadily getting to the winner. BILL OF RIGHTS within striking distance, raced three wide on the turn and tired in the drive. NECK 'N NECK outsprinted early, raced in the three path on the turn and lodged only a mild bid for the place. ADMIRAL NELSON outrun early, made a middle move off the inside but could not sustain the bid. JASIZZLE forced the pace off the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. DESERT DOC outrun early, raced in the six path on the turn and was no threat. REAL LUCK prompted the early pace between rivals, was four wide midway through the turn and faded. TIZANEXPENSE ducked in after the start, was outrun inside and never menaced. BRIGADE within striking distance four wide, faded. AMERICAN BEAR forwardly placed off the inside, stopped. INDIO CARLOS prominent four wide, stopped.
