EDDIE SET GO reserved five wide, made a bold move on the second turn, drew clear into the stretch and held sway late. PROUD JARED outrun for a half, bumped with KID GALLAHAD in upper stretch when that one was bumped out then was gaining late. CODOY forwardly placed four wide, challenged after a half, battled to the stretch and tired. KID GALAHAD outrun early off the rail, made a good middle move, was bumped out in upper stretch and lacked a late bid. PIOUS PREACHER behind the leaders three wide, moved up off the rail on the second turn, gained a short lead between calls approaching the stretch but tired in the drive. RIKI MCD outrun, raced off the inside on the second turn, angled out for the drive and showed late interest. ROCKSIDE ROAD reserved four wide, raced in the three path on the second turn, bumped KID GALLAHAD out in upper stretch and tired. PROUD WARRIOR eager early

three wide, angled out for the drive and could not threaten. SMAK DAB close up three wide, tired. PARTY HARD forced the pace off the inside and faded. JERSEY DEVIL set the pace along the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. LOLA'S THEATRICAL was through early.
