VILLANDRY settled saving ground, took closer order through the second turn, waited briefly entering the stretch, got through with three-sixteenths to run, shot through and opened clear, was taken in hand through the final fifty yards score with something left. TIGERDUDE attended the pace along the inside, shifted out leaving the second turn, tucked back to the inside for the final furlong and finished willingly to earn the place. STREET SERENADE bumped with SHUN at the start, tracked the pace three wide, drew even leaving the second turn, but weakened during in the final furlong and settled for the show. STRONG HOLD was allowed to settle, ranged up five wide to make a mild bid but flattened during the drive. SHUN was squeezed between horses at the start, settled in hand three wide while never far back, moved up four wide to engage the leaders leaving the second turn, but weakened between horses and gave way. ATLANTIC TITAN broke outwardly bumping SHUN, opened clear to set the pace, was collared leaving the second turn, drifted out a bit entering the stretch and faltered between horses. DRIVEN FORCE brushed the gate, was away behind his field and was never a factor.
