KISS IN THE FOREST behind the leaders three wide, challenged once in the stretch and drew off late under steady urging. STANDING BY vied for the lead from the start, raced three wide into the turn, moved in a bit with three furlongs to go, battled to the final furlong and held on for the place while no match for the winner late. SNOW KISSED in tight at the start, was out sprinted early, raced three wide on the turn, angled out for the drive and made a late gain. CAT LORE bothered early by GILHOOLY'S SUPER, recovered to race within striking distance off the rail but lacked a rally. FRONTIER COUNTRY outrun to the stretch, made a belated bid. LUNE within striking distance along the inside, angled out for the drive and lacked a rally. GILHOOLY'S SUPER came in a bit early bothering CAT LORE, forced the early pace between rivals and faded. ALYDARLA bumped early, forced the pace along the inside and faded.
