COUNTESS DIANA gained the lead inside at the start, controlled the pace under careful handling, settled into the stretch with a clear advance, was roused twice with the whip on the right side and concluded under vigorous hand urging. TASSO'S MAGIC ROO, well placed from the start, angled out for the drive, couldn't menace the winner but was clearly second best. ASLEWOFWHITE, unhurried for a half, made a mild bid to reach contention at the eighth pole but lacked a further account. BLARIN SPEED, also unhurried early, made a run six wide approaching the stretch, loomed prominently but also failed to gain in the final furlong. CHELSIE'S HOUSE, well placed while four or five wide, flattened out when the test came. VICTORICA moved inside and save ground to no avail. IT'S AN ECHO went up early to press the winner from the outside, held on well until the stretch and tired. DAKE was finished after a half as was HOT N CODE.
