Footnotes

INDYGO SHINER, rated in behind the dueling leaders from the start, saved ground until nearing the final quarter, angled three or four wide, took over and edged clear under strong handling. NORTHERN FANTASY moved inside on the backstretch, rallied from the rail on the second turn, angled between foes four wide nearing the stretch, loomed a solid threat but wasn't good enough. NEWSPEAK, six wide on the backstretch, edged in a bit around the far turn came out eight wide for the drive and offered a mild gain. MADELEINE'S JADE was sent to the fore soon after the start, went along under careful handling, made the pace until the stretch and weakened. LIKE TO TALK, never far back while following the leaders four wide, was empty in the drive. EIGHTIES, outrun inside from the start, made a run to reach prominence at the furlong grounds but flattened out soon after. HIT THE HARDWOOD pressed pacesetting MADELEINE'S JADE until the stretch and tired. CHIEF'S HOGAN, well placed from early on while tracking the leaders five wide, weakened approaching the stretch. WESTERN SQUIRE, steadied sharply between foes soon after the start when appearing rank, moved inside, raced in a contending position until the stretch and tired.
