Footnotes

FAVORITE FUN chased front-running SWISSLE STICK from early on while four wide, took over entering the upper stretch, kicked clear and was kept to his task. BLAMETHEBOSSANOVA, never far back while following the leaders four or five wide, loomed prominently outside the winner through the drive and couldn't produce the needed response as second best. ELECTRIC LIGHT, outprinted on the backstretch and five wide, edged in around the turn, angled out entering the lane to again race five wide and couldn't offer a closing threat. JAMAICA BAY, bumped at the start and forced in, was checked, raced near the inside, reached contention entering the lane, angled three or four wide but lacked a late response. SWISSLE STICK sprinted clear near the inside early, made the pace to the stretch and gave way. STRIKE, sluggish to begin and three wide while outrun for a half, came out six or seven wide for the drive and never menaced. THREE CUBITS ducked in at the start bumping JAMAICA BAY, raced five wide and never menaced. UNCLE JAMIE raced forwardly for a half while four wide and faded.
