PRINCE TETON was allowed to settle, commenced his bid circling five wide and was fully extended to wear down PRIZE MASTER in the final strides. PRIZE MASTER set the pressured pace toward the inside, battled gamely through a prolonged drive but grudgingly gave way late. RADAR MAN angled in and attended the pace along the inside, got through and was up in time to earn the show. LINEBACKER vied for the lead three wide, kept on well through a long drive but weakened slightly late. CHECKSANDBALANCES pressed the pace two wide, but weakened late and faded. NEWPORT was unhurried into stride, split horses entering the stretch to make his move, was blocked and steadied nearing the furlong marker, altered course to the outside and came

again once clear. SATYRS settled along the inside, got through to make a belated gain but failed to threaten. MY BOY JO contended between horses for five furlongs and faded. MONTY CAT failed to respond. EXCURSION was forwardly placed four wide for a half and dropped out. WIN GRAMMY BOY was allowed to settle, came six wide into the stretch, was taken up late and eased to the wire.
