Footnotes

POWERFUL GOER, outsprinted early but saving ground from early on, angled four wide entering the stretch and responded to energetic handling to wear down TRY N EXPRESS. The latter gained the lead early, maneuvered inside, was headed approaching the final furlong from the outside by CRUCIBLE, regained the advantage and just failed to last. CRUCIBLE pressed pacesetting TRY N EXPRESS from early on, headed that one at the furlong grounds but failed to sustain the needed momentum. SOLD TO WALLSTREET, well placed and saving ground into the stretch, came up empty when the test came. HOWLIN WOLF, outrun for a half, improved position while not a serious threat. SUPER MARFALOUS, well placed, made a menacing run five wide leaving the turn but flattened out when straightened for the drive. LEESTOWN was outrun. TWILIGHT TRICK was finished upon going a half. FLAG ON THE PLAY was not a factor.
