PYRITE FAB contested the pace inside from early on, took over nearing the stretch, edged clear, then increased her advantage under intermittent urging in a sharp effort. LADY GALLAPIAT, never far back and racing in behind the dueling leaders until leaving the turn, loomed prominently outside the winner for the drive, wasn't a match but clearly handled the others. MISS CHEERS, well placed into the stretch inside, lacked a closing response. RAHY ROSE, outrun until approaching the stretch, made a mild bid to reach contention nearing the final furlong but lacked a further account. GULLEY improved position while not a threat. ROUND ROBIN stalked the pace four or five wide for almost a half and faded. IDENTIFIABLE saved ground to no avail. PLAYFUL SQUAW was outrun to the stretch and passed tired ones. RANBA was done early. ON MY LAST NERVE vied for the lead for nearly a half and tired. ANNA STERZ gave way early.
