Footnotes

AUNT CONNIE, well placed inside from early on, eased out three or four wide for the stretch run, caught front-running DARBY'S CHARM a sixteenth out and prevailed under strong handling. DARBY'S CHARM gained the lead early, moved near the inside, made the pace until the final sixteenth and couldn't match strides with AUNT CONNIE in the late going. GRAND MODEL, bumped at the start and forced in, was checked at the half-mile ground, continued within easy striking distance, four wide into the final furlong and flattened out. TRIXIE CHICK, outrun to the stretch while racing behind horses, was four wide into the lane, angled nearer the inside for the final furlong and improved position while unable to menace. PICKI went up early to force the pace, raced outside of front-running DARBY'S CHARM, held on well until the stretch and weakened thereafter. COIN TRICK, briefly in front after the start, followed the leaders in a challenging position four or five wide to the stretch and weakened. SEANS BEAUTY raced in contention to the stretch while five wide and tired. FIRE PLACE raced near the inside throughout and never menaced. UNIQUE was outrun. SWEET CANE ducked at the start bumping GRAND MODEL and never was prominent. INSUFFICIENT FUNDS faded upon going a half.
