Footnotes

GREAT BLOOM, never far back while racing in hand three or four wide, advanced steadily four wide approaching the stretch, was inside of DR. KASHNIKOW, put a head in front at the eighth pole and edged clear late under strong handling. DR. KASHNIKOW, well placed from the start, raced in behind rivals under a rating hold, eased outside the winner four or five wide approaching the stretch, reached the front briefly between calls in the upper stretch and couldn't match strides with GREAT BLOOM late. RED MOUNTAIN stalked front-running CRAFTY SHAW from early on while three or four wide, inched to challenge approaching the final quarter, gained even terms for the lead inside the top two but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. PRIVATE SON, within striking distance while near the inside to the end of the backstretch, edged out between foes four wide on the far turn, made a run into the upper stretch but failed to continue. CRAFTY SHAW gained the lead early, maneuvered inside while able, made the pace until the final quarter and weakened. GET DOWN WOLFIE broke in the air to trail, was unhurried six wide on the backstretch, continued six abreast to make a run between calls into the upper stretch but flattened out. CLASSIC PAR, five wide most of the way, failed to menace. DIA ALEGRE (CHI), unhurried early, raced in behind foes, was between horses four wide in the drive and never fired. FORD EVERY STREAM, checked behind CRAFTY SHAW approaching the first turn, continued inside, appeared to hop a shadow on the course at the half-mile ground and weakened nearing the final quarter.
