WANDERIN BOY edged in a bit early while gaining a slim lead, raced CELTIC MOJO into submission entering the upper stretch and moved clear under hand urging. MAKERS AT MIDNIGHT worked his way near the inside early, was never far back, eased out three wide for the drive, was just off the winner for the final furlong and couldn't menace late while fully extended. CELTIC MOJO went up inside early to contest the pace, battled with the winner to the stretch and weakened. CASH KING, never far back, raced five or six wide entering the stretch and failed to gain in the final furlong. TERRIFIC STORM, bumped at the start and checked, raced in behind horses while outrun, came out six wide into the final furlong and offered a mild gain. DIPLOMATIC AGENT, outrun to the stretch, made a mild bid to reach contention at the furlong grounds and failed to continue. BACK IN THE SADDLE never threatened. BAILOUT WITH STYLE, bumped at the start and forced in, failed to rally. QUAPAW CHARLIE tracked the dueling leaders four or five wide to the stretch and tired. SHAWNEE WARRIOR faded after a half. CRUGUET (ARG) bore in at the start bumping BAILOUTWITH STYLE, drifted out on the turn, continued 10 wide and wasn't persevered with. BANO'S ADIL ducked out at the start bumping TERRIFIC STORM, then was outrun.
