Footnotes

REPOSE reserved three wide, advanced four wide on the second turn, took over in midstretch and drew clear under steady urging. TINK SO angled in early, advanced inside into the second turn, angled out five wide approaching the stretch and finished willingly to be up for the place. WHEN MO MONEY unhurried early, made a solid five wide move late on the second turn, reached a striking position with a furlong to go but went evenly late. GALASHEY close up early in the three path, dropped back a bit before a half, stayed in that path on the second turn and lacked a closing bid. RUN FOR FREEDOM within striking distance early along the inside, saved ground on the second turn, came off the rail for the drive, steadied attempting to split rivals with a furlong to go then had no late bid. HONORABLE CRUSADER reared at the start, was outrun for a half, advanced inside on the second turn, angled out in the stretch and finished willingly. PRETTY ALICE set the early pace off the inside, held on well to midstretch and gave way. CLEAR CONSCIENCE within striking distance three wide, moved out a bit on the second turn, drifted in and out with a sixteenth to go and weakened. MINER'S MEADOW forwardly placed four wide, was in tight when still prominent with a furlong to go and faded. SMOOCHABLE alternated for the lead three wide and faded. QUEEN CHESTENE five wide on the first turn, could not menace. ROSES N CHOCOLATE was no factor.
