MY JEN closest to the pace three wide, challenged the leader with a furlong to go, drew clear then lasted late. AFLEET MAGGI within striking distance off the rail, moved out five wide leaving the turn and closed well late. ATTEMPT TO NAME broke in the air, was outrun early, raced four wide on the turn, angled out for the drive and made a late gain. ENCORE SARITTA sprinted clear, set the pace off the inside, held on well to the final sixteenth and tired. MISS DIANE within striking distance, raced six wide into the turn, dropped back into the stretch then had no late bid. LELA reserved early, raced five wide into the turn and could not menace. CREDIT CRUNCH prominent four wide, faded. LUNAR MIST unprepared at the start, recovered to be forwardly placed along the inside but faded. CLOCKWORK ANGEL was no threat. IMAGINE NOW was outrun.
