VALEDICTION set the pressured pace toward the inside, shook clear entering the stretch and held safely. COUNTY ARMAGH stalked the pace, moved up four wide to make his bid, was unable to match strides with the winner but had enough left to hold the place. MY WAHOO was allowed to settle, angled out five wide, closed the gap on the turn, but lacked the needed late response. DISCUSSION CLOSED was unhurried into stride, came five wide and finished with a mild rally. PAULISTANO was slow into stride, circled six wide and improved position. THOMAS JEFFERSON was hustled along between horses but lacked a response when called upon. PAROLED was allowed to settle, made a belated gain along the inside. BARTOW pressed the pace between horses, but came up empty on the turn and dropped out. MOUNT CERVIN chased three wide but was through before going a half. WINE TIME was forwardly place along the inside through the turn and stopped.
