Footnotes

TOUCH DIAL contested the pace inside from early on, gained the lead approaching the stretch, then increased her advantage when kept to energetic handling in the late stages. WIND TUNNEL gained a narrow lead early while dueling outside the winner, battled on about even terms with that one into the stretch and weakened. TRAVEATA made a mild bid to reach contention in the upper stretch but lacked a further response. DESERT CLARITY improved position while not a threat. LADY MONARCH failed to menace. WHISPER AND RUN, well placed inside to the stretch, weakened when the test came. MY SWEET CAROLINE was outrun. WHAT A BOUT gave way midway of the turn. SOUTH BOUNDARY was wide on the backstretch and swerved out approaching the stretch to avoid an injured rival. TRAUDE was outrun. RAE RAE, off slowly, swerved in after breaking, rushed to contention outside the dueling leaders, then broke down suddenly a quarter-mile out.
